Clean: Clean your hands with soap and water or use a hand sanitizing gel when water is not available. **Cover:** Cover your coughs and sneezes with your sleeve or elbow.

Contain: Contain germs by staying home when ill. Do not go to school, work, shopping, or other outside activities while you are sick.

If you are ill, have run a fever in the last 14 days or have been in known contact with anyone that is suspected to have Covid-19 it is recommended that you stay at home.

 - Food truck available for carry-away dining.
- RESTROOMS
 - Limit # of persons in restrooms
 - $_{\odot}$ Additional port-a-pots have been brough in to help reduce lines
- CLOSED OFFICE
 - Limited office staff.

- INDOOR WARM UP ARENA
