Futurity / Derby Guidelines

FUTURITY HORSE

Defined as a horse 5 and under not entered in any barrel racing competitions prior to November 15 of the year prior to its competition year.

DERBY HORSE

Defined as a horse 8 & under (no longer futurity age). A horse may have more than one derby year depending on the age it started its competitive career.

- Any entrant knowingly competing on a horse not meeting the above criteria will forfeit all money and prizes won and may be disqualified from current and future Go For Broke Productions events.
- Futurity and Derby will pay back 100% of advertised added money.
- Entry fees are paid back at a minimum of 75% of entry fees collected.
- 30% paid out to each Futurity go round.
- 2D Format • 1 second split • Progressive pay scale for the Futurity.
- 30% paid out to each Derby go round.
- 2D Format • ½ second split • Progressive pay scale for the Derby.
- 40% paid back in the Futurity & Derby Average.
- Both Futurity & Derby Average payouts will use a 2D format.
- Awards TBD at the discretion of GFB office.
- A paid in full entry may be sold to another eligible contestant.
- Review event refund policies before selling spots.
- Rider must be declared at Horse Check-In.
- Horse/Rider changes are NOT allowed after specific event posted buy/sell deadlines.
- The same rider must compete on the horse in both go rounds.
- Futurity & Derby entries entered in the Open 5D will automatically roll over.
- This also applies to Youth, Adult, Masters, and side pots.
- If entered in a Slot Race, the Futurity/Derby run carries to the Open. The slot race would then be a separate stand-alone run.
- All Futurity & Derby contestants must check in with a COPY OF PAPERS.
- Contestants will receive a saddle pad number that must be displayed during both go rounds.
- Check-in times and locations will be posted for each event.
- Random draws will be posted on SaddleBook
 - LATE ENTRIES will be added to the end of the draw
- Second go rounds will run in complete reverse order
- All standard Go For Broke Productions competition rules apply unless otherwise noted.
- A downed barrel results in a NO TIME for that go round and any carry-over classes.
- A horse going off pattern will receive a NO TIME.

FULL HOUSE INCENTIVE (FHI)

- The Full House Incentive is open to ANY sire.
- Anyone may pay a stallion into the FHI program.
- If someone other than the stallion owner pays the enrollment fee, they should have owner consent acknowledging breeder payout rights.
- 100% of annual enrollment fees are returned through payouts and awards.
- Added money is allocated between Futurity, Derby, and Open side pots.
- Open Side Pot: \$35 EF • 90% payback • 3D format • .5 second split.
- Stallion owner payouts are 30% of the total pot when the FHI Side Pot added money exceeds \$1,000 added.
- FHI Futurity Average: \$50 EF • 90% payback.
- Average & \$1000+ Added Open payout split: 70% horse/rider • 30% stallion owner.
- Paid placings determined by entries and enrollments.
- Any unpaid monies due to unfilled placings may be redistributed at GFB discretion.

Situations not specifically covered above will be handled at the discretion of Go For Broke Productions officials and event management.
